



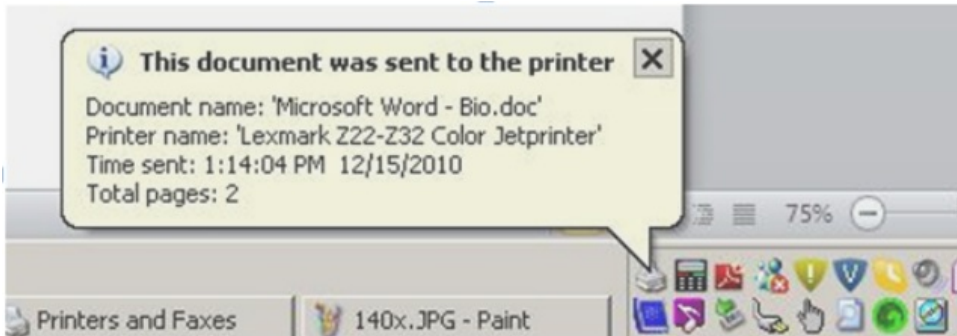
How can I get the Notification bubble to appear in my system tray when I print to the PDFeXPLODE printer or any other printer

I would like to get a notification when my workstation PDFeXPLODE printer processes the Print output and sends it to the server for processing. How can I do this?

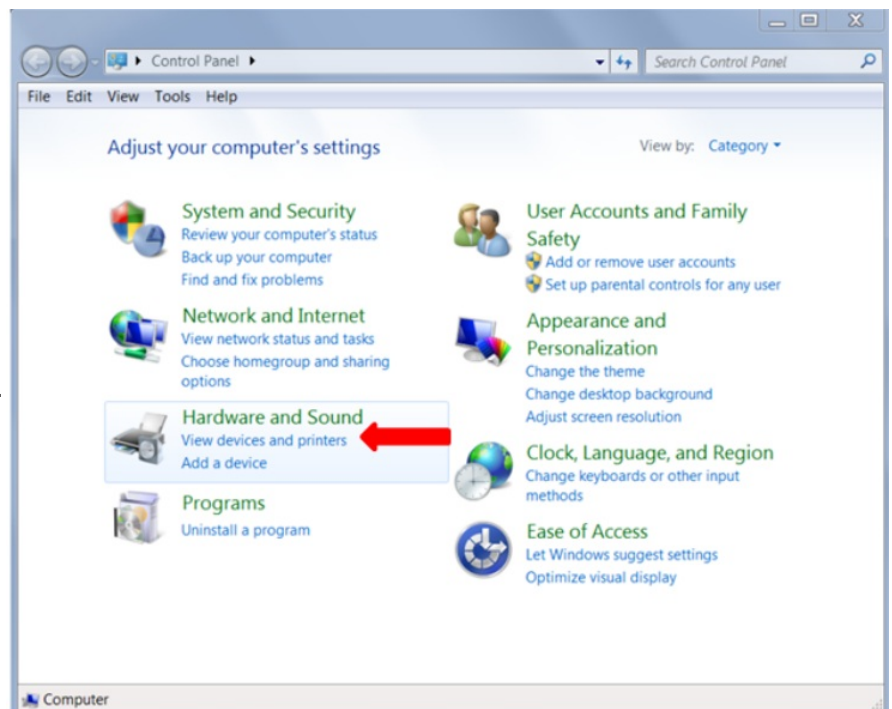
This is what I would like to appear in the system tray.



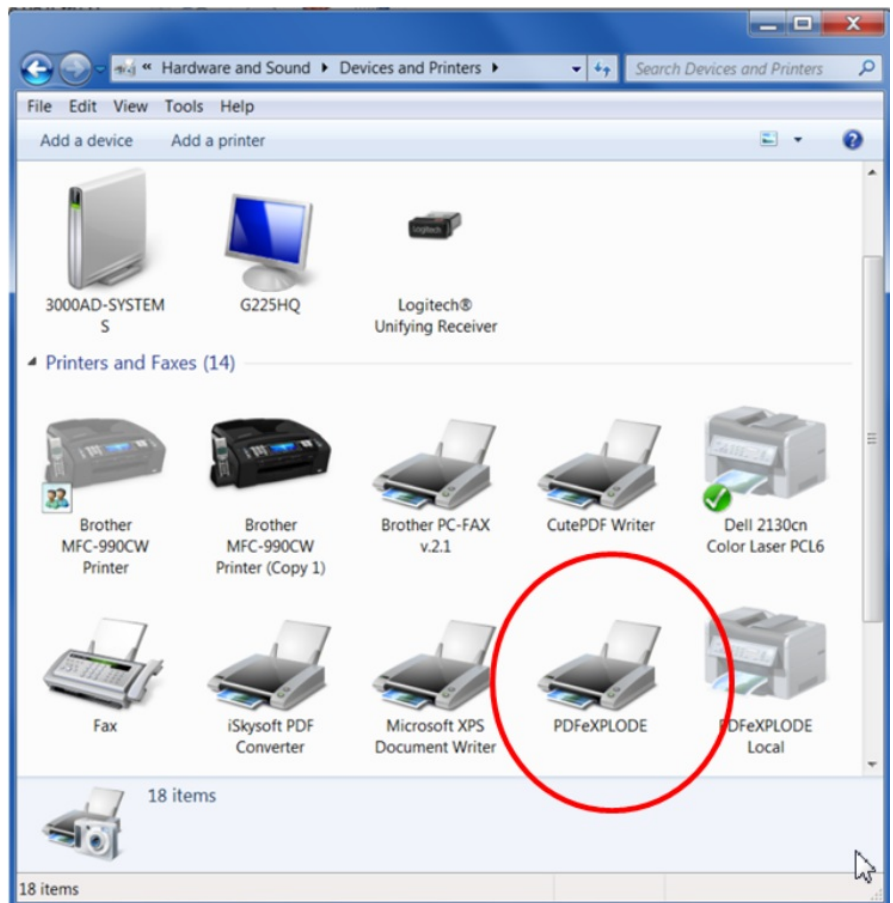
ANSWER:

Follow these step by step instructions. You can either remove or update Printer notifications using these instructions.

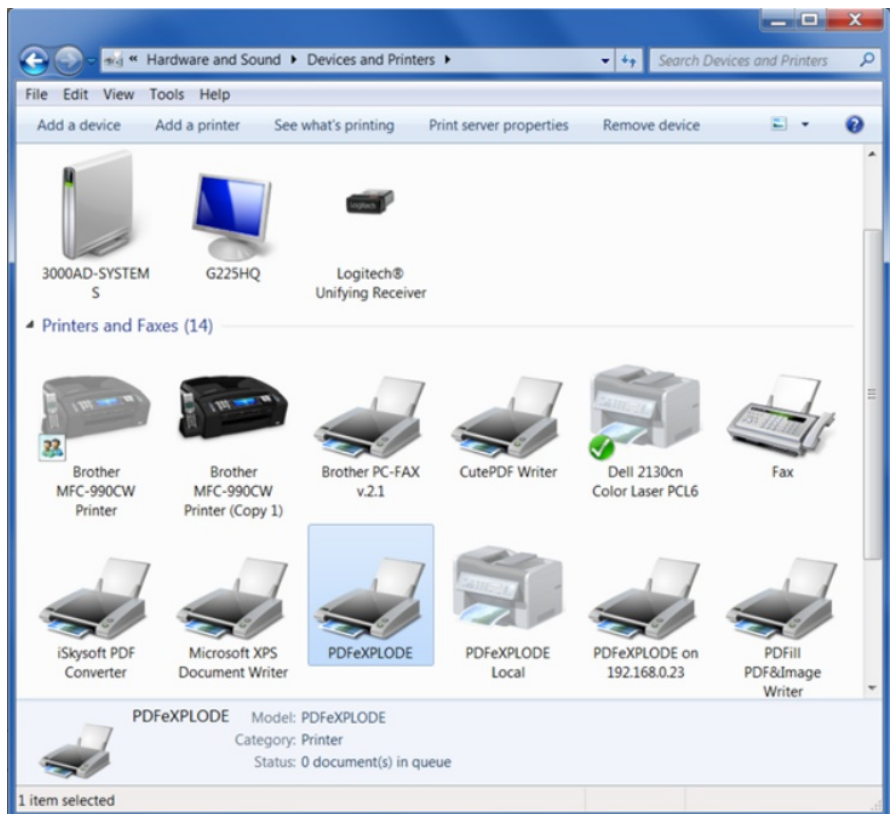
1. Go to **Start > Control Panel > Hardware and Sound** and select "**View devices and Printers**" with a left mouse click.



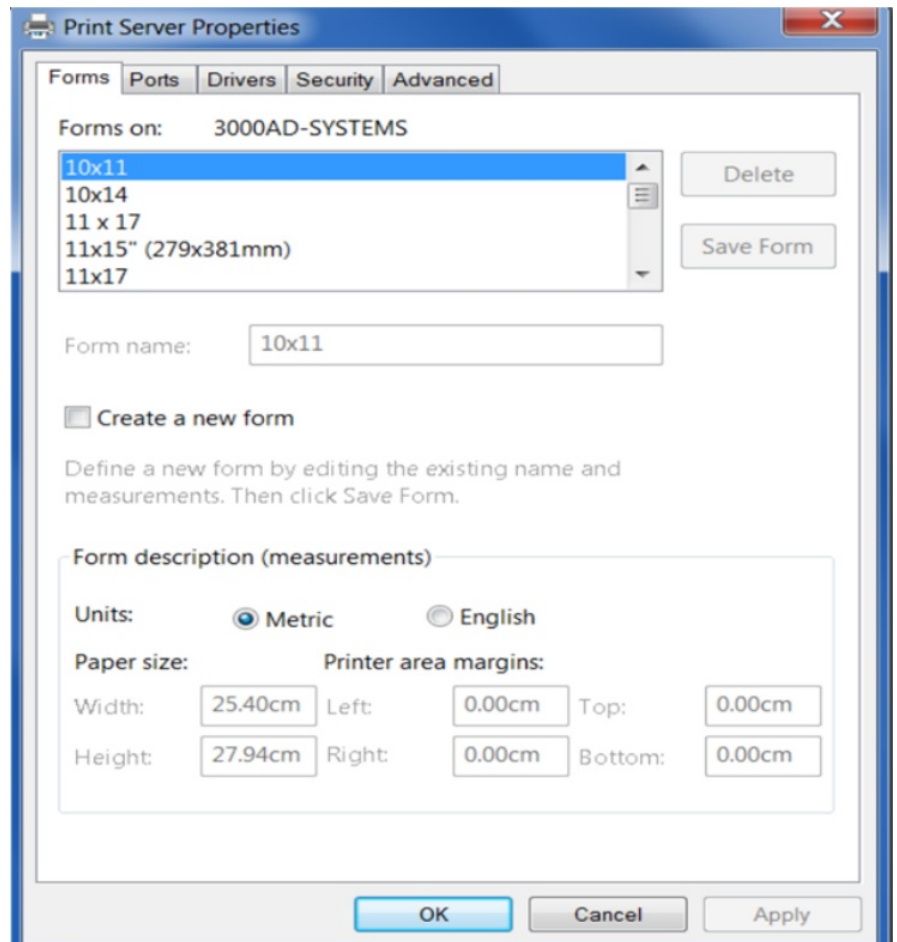
2. **Devices and Printers** Panel displays (Windows 7).



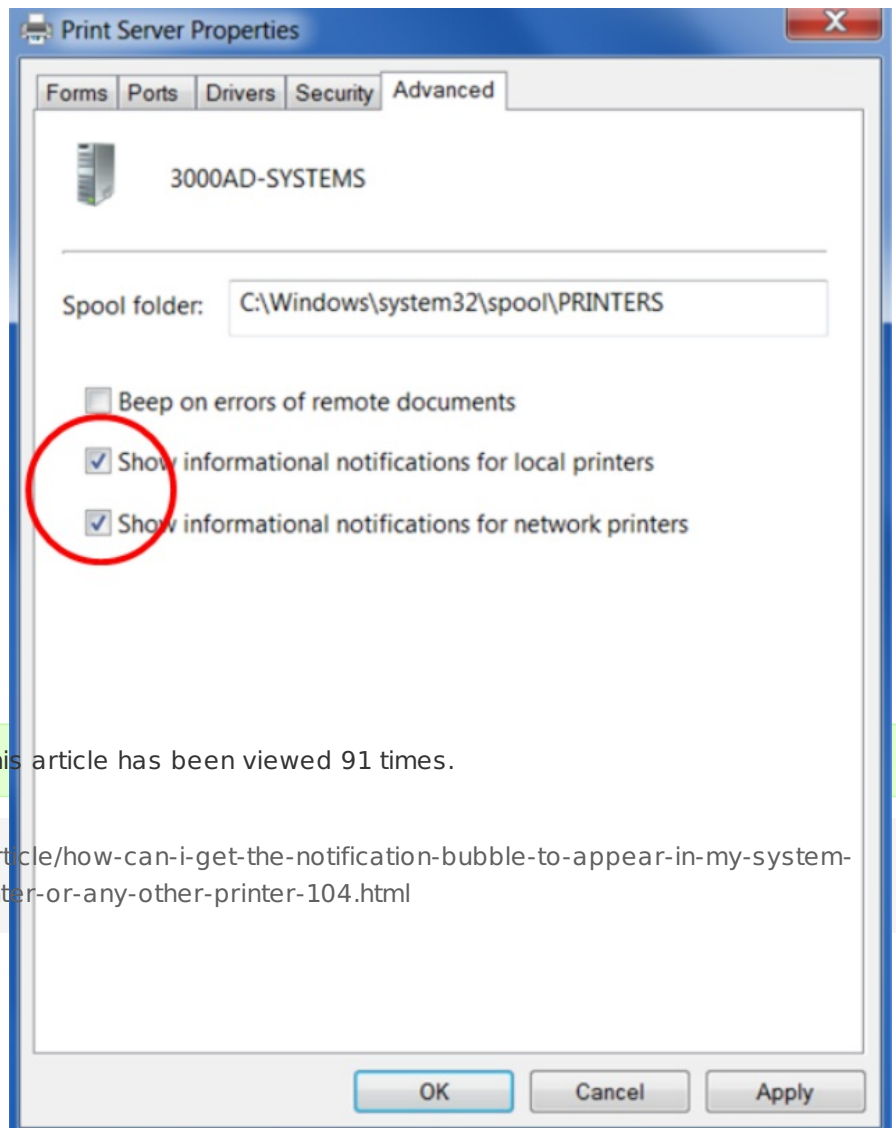
3. Left click (once) on PDFeXPLODE printer (or any printer of your choice) The **Print server properties** option will display on the toolbar below the “File Edit View...” menu



4. **Left click** on the "**Print server properties**" option in the menu bar **that appears** at the top. This will open and display a Printer properties screen



5. Now click on the 'Advanced' tab to open the screen. **Then check both boxes as indicated** to implement 'Printer notifications' or **uncheck both boxes** to remove 'Printer notifications'.
6. **Click APPLY** to make changes and then click **OK to exit** and save your selection
